#### Ordinance 742 RELATED TO CATS

70-19 B. Any person who owns, keeps or harbors any cat located within Trainer Borough or permits a cat to enter Trainer Borough shall exercise sufficient and proper care and control over such animal at all times so as to prevent the animal from becoming a public nuisance or other violation of this article.

70-19 I. Every owner or possessor of real property in Trainer Borough shall prevent or remove any and all accumulations of animal waste, feces or excretions on such property within seven days, if such accumulations create obnoxious odors outside the property or unhealthy conditions.

**Ordinance 765** has been updated in regards to cleaning up animal feces within 24 hours on PUBLIC and PRIVATE property. **Fines will be imposed**. Each day's failure to comply shall constitute a separate violation.


